## Guidelines/Procedures

Please read the following guidelines and procedures carefully, and then sign and date the release form on the back of this page. Make a copy for your records and return this form with your entry.

- Entry deadline is Friday, September 13th, 2024, at 3:30 p.m.
- Any club, civic organization, youth center team, band, or church is invited to have an entry in the parade.
- The theme for all entries is "Beat Skiatook." Their mascot is the bulldog, so feel free to incorporate that as well (Bash the Bulldogs, Stomp Skiatook, etc.). You may do whatever you like with your entry; this is just a suggestion.
- You should have a sign identifying your organization/entry in the parade.
- If music is used in your entry, it should be family-friendly.
- The parade host and its sponsors cannot be responsible for children. If your entry involves children, please be sure that you have an adequate number of adults to provide supervision.
- You need to make your own arrangements with parents to have their children dropped off and picked up from your parade entry. Drop-off CANNOT be in the parade line-up on Broadway Street. This is strictly prohibited. Please plan to meet at another location at a certain time, or on one of the side roads that run north/south and then take the entry to the line-up location on Broadway. You can also have your entry riders/walkers WALK to the entry line-up location on Broadway.
- Per the Cushing Police Dept., for safety reasons, NO candy or novelties are to be thrown or tossed from floats or from walking participants. IF caught throwing, tossing, OR handing candy and/or novelties from floats, trucks, OR parade entrants, that parade entry will be banned from next year's Homecoming Parade.
